You can grant consent to all the purposes, one of the purposes or to none of the purposes. Where you do not grant consent, we will not be able to use your personal data, e.g., we may not be able to let you know about the forthcoming services and events, except in certain limited situations, such as where we are required to do so by law or to protect members of public from serious harm. You can find out more about how we use your data from our “**Data Privacy Notice**” attached to this form.

You can withdraw or change your consent at any time by contacting the Secretary of Holy Trinity CSI Congregation Dublin. Please note that all processing of your personal data will cease once you have withdrawn consent, other than where this is required by law. This will not affect any personal data that has already been processed prior to this point.

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

The General Data Protection (GDPR) came into effect across Europe from 25th May 2018. It replaced the existing law on data protection and gives individuals more rights and protection in how their personal data is used by organisations. Personal data in this context is defined as information about a living person which is capable of identifying them.

Parishes must comply with the requirements of GDPR, just like any other charity or organisation. If charities are not compliant, they can face a fine up to 4% of their turnover or €20million, whichever is larger.

In line with the requirements of GDPR, your personal details will be deleted from the parish registers unless this consent form is signed and submitted.
